MAKE THE SWITCH TO STREAMING!

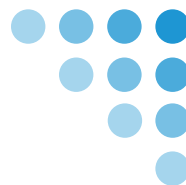
If you haven't already switched to streaming TV service, the process and the many options can feel a bit overwhelming. There are many benefits to streaming, including the flexibility to start and stop service, the ability to take it wherever you go, choose content that you are interested in watching, and potentially saving some money! It's worth comparing and here's your guide to getting started!

WHAT DO I NEED TO GET STARTED?

- **You need three things:**
 - a. Internet Connection
 - b. A Device to Stream On
 - c. A Streaming Subscription
- **You have the reliable internet connection down with DayStarr! Next you need a smart TV with built-in capability, OR a streaming device such as a Roku or Amazon Fire Stick.**

SELECTING A STREAMING SERVICE

- **Determine what networks you are interested in streaming.** (i.e. local channels, HGTV, ESPN)
- **Visit www.suppose.tv to compare streaming packages.** Select the networks you are interested in, or type them into the search box. Once you've made your selections, you will be shown what packages are available, for how much, etc.



SUBSCRIBE TO A SERVICE

- If you used suppose.tv to find the subscription that fits you best, select “see details” or “see offer” to sign up and subscribe to said service.
- Have your e-mail address and a new password for the streaming service ready.
- Have a credit card ready for purchase of subscription.

PLUG IN YOUR STREAMING DEVICE

- If you use a smart TV, you can skip this step. Plug your streaming device into the HDMI outlet, and power.
- Switch your TV over to the HDMI input. To do this, select input on your remote and continue to press the input button until you get to the HDMI input. Follow the instructions on the screen.

CONNECT TO THE INTERNET

- You will need to connect to your home internet. If you do not have your WIFI ID and password memorized, this can be found on the back label of your router.
- On your home screen, navigate to settings, followed by network, then connect and activate now. Choose wireless, followed by set up new wireless connection. Select your desired network and enter your WIFI password, and click OK to connect.

DOWNLOAD & SIGN IN TO STREAMING APPS

- Popular streaming services like Netflix will come pre-downloaded on your TV or device.
- If you have subscribed to a service that you are not seeing pre-downloaded onto your device, you will need to download it.
- To download an app, first select apps from your home screen and hit enter. You may scroll around to find what you are looking for, OR you can browse apps. To search apps by name, select app search, enter app name, and press enter to install. Some of your favorite apps may not be available on our smart TV or device.
